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Fictional document, produced for demonstration. **IT is not at fault: it receives the requests after the arrival.**

Step	Average time
Contract signature → access request	9 days
Request → opening	1.4 days
Total as felt by the arrival	6 days after arriving

The delay is in the request, not in IT. That is what decomposing it changes, and neither of the two departments involved could see it from where they stood.

With no access on day one	23
Days present with no means of working	~138

That is the measurable part, and it says nothing about what the person makes of it. The agent sticks to what it can count.
