An information meeting, a progress check, a catch-up after an absence do not have to produce a decision — and demanding that they do is the surest way to obtain premature ones.

A project review with no decision does not mean the same as a team check-in with no decision: **it is the 6 that prompted discussion**, and two changed format.

23 of 60 meetings with no decision, split by type: 17 team check-ins, 6 project reviews	Removing, shortening or reshaping a meeting is decided at your end — and two of the six reviews have already changed format on this table alone
