The 21 crossings ruled out — the fact that rules them out, entity by entity

Ternoise Maroc	9	Neither established in the Union, nor placing a system on the Union market — both limbs of the territorial scope were checked and both are absent
Ternoise Levage	6	Operates none of the tools concerned — trading activity with no AI system declared in the repository
Ternoise Belgium	4	Does not operate the screening tool or the assessment tool; the obligation stays with the holding

The linkage conclusion nobody had seen

Finding	What establishes it	Consequence
The CV screening tool is operated by the holding on behalf of all seven companies	Deposited intra-group services agreement, article 3	A single entity carries the obligation for the group , and it is not the one doing the hiring
The owner of the gap changes	Deposited process repository, "hiring" record	The gap is addressed to group HR, not to the subsidiary managers
Ternoise Portuaire holds a double role	Product record "embedded diagnostic module"	One company is a deployer for some tools and a provider for one product; the two sets of obligations are kept apart
