## Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

**Fictional document**, produced for the demonstration. Group, subsidiaries, assets, advisories and people are invented. **This is the INPUT document: it lists what you deposited, not what the agent went out and fetched.** No system was queried, scanned or modified — **external writes: 0.**

**The supplier register is one hour past your threshold, and it is accepted anyway — because nothing is concluded from it.** It supplies the contact named in the framework contract, a fact that does not age at the speed of a software version.

**The rule is written down: a source past the threshold is accepted with its date on display when it feeds no priority calculation, and refused the moment it does.**

**The DEMO-CVE prefix is not a flourish.** A real vulnerability identifier copied into a demonstration ends up circulating as though Blue Lemon Agent had investigated that

very vulnerability on your estate. **These four identifiers are fictional, and they say so to the eye as well as to the test suite.**

## The policy applied, and the fact that it is yours

**Two lines in this table are not administrable.** Human approval before any write, and the ban on automatic production changes, are not settings: they are product controls. **No conversation with the agent changes them**, and that is what makes everything else safe to configure.

**What this deposit does not contain, deliberately:** no feed from a public vulnerability database, no direct access to a scanner, a configuration database or a deployment tool. **The agent works on what you deposit, in the format you**

**already produce.** The set of sources retained for your organisation is named during scoping and appears in the quotation.

Group, subsidiaries, provider, exports, advisories, versions and dates invented for the demonstration. They illustrate a situation common in holding companies; they describe no real group.

Scope of this document: the service operated by Blue Lemon Agent. For an agent deployed at your premises, the applicable location is that of the architecture set out in the quotation and verified before commissioning; local execution is announced only for the configuration explicitly described and accepted in the quotation; the applicable isolation depends on the deployment mode set out in the quotation, no dedicated isolation being presumed; the encryption mechanisms in transit and at rest, their components and key management are those documented for the architecture chosen; roles and permissions are configured and accepted for the identities and systems actually connected; the events logged, their content, their retention period and who may access them are defined for the deployment chosen.
