The tools show them as "pending", and the organiser reads them as probable attendance. The format, the room and the agenda were then chosen for a headcount that does not exist.

What replaces the chase, and what it earns you

A chase on a recurring invitation arrives every week and becomes noise people filter out — it makes worse exactly what it claims to fix. What works lies elsewhere: the **38%** with no reply come back to you as such, clearly separated from acceptances and declines, and completed by attendance actually observed where it is available. Format, room and agenda are then chosen on a real headcount, across the 2,940 occurrences you organise.
