Fictional document — demonstration example

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Fictional document, produced for demonstration. **No renewal is requested by the agent**: a certificate request commits the company and requires information it does not have.

What the rules require, quoted

"Certificates produced must be valid at the date of submission of tenders."

Tender rules, article 6.2. Quoted because not all rules require it the same way — some accept a certificate valid at the date of application.

A	31/08/2026	Tender 1	11/09	No — 11 days
B	14/09/2026	Tenders 2 and 3	18/09 and 02/10	No for both

Certificate	Expires	Tenders concerned	Submission	Valid at submission?
C	30/11/2026	Tender 4	15/11	Yes
D	22/12/2026	None live	—	—

Certificate B is the one nobody would see: it expires on 14/09, that is after the 11/09 submission causing concern today — but before two other submissions already committed to.

Obtaining times

Body	Observed time	Margin available
Certificate A	2 to 15 days	23 days
Certificate B	5 to 10 days	37 days

What was missing

Not the list of expiry dates: that exists. It is the cross-reference of those dates with submission deadlines — and that cross-reference happens in neither of the two tools holding the two halves of the information.

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
