Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **The inventory is built read-only**: no file was moved, renamed or modified. *The document base is every document the company keeps and uses, whatever the source it sits in.*

What each of the nine sources holds

Source	Documents	Main content	What it brings to the base
Quality document system	38,400	Procedures, work instructions, records	The only source carrying a version register
Technical documentation	51,200	Manuals, parts lists, drawings	The heart of the business — maintenance returns to it daily
File server	46,900	Production run files, minutes	Structured by site, not by project

Collaboration spaces (2)	39,700	Live projects, attachments	Where duplicates are born
Intranet	8,600	Service notes, templates	Internal distribution

The gap the inventory brings to light

Measured finding	Value	What it costs today
Searches confined to a single source	71%	The person finds a document without knowing another one exists elsewhere
Documents present in at least two sources	61,400 — 29% of the base	Two copies of the same text, two access paths, two sets of rights
of which copies NOT identical to each other	12,300	This is the population that produces version errors
Annual hours spent looking for documents	3,640 h	More than two full-time equivalents, from the activity records

The time unified search shifts

Task	Today	With the platform	In hours
Source-by-source search	65% of the time a document search takes	7%	3,640 h → 392 h a year

What does not change: the nine sources stay in place, with their paths, their file names and their habits. **The platform reads; it writes into no source.** Ending the subscription would leave the nine sources exactly as they stand today.
